HB 52	Wuchner	Healthy Kids Act: develop reporting mechanism for schools with grades K-5 on physical activity, aggregate BMI, and wellness program data; more
HB 74	Tilley	Require CHFS to develop employer wellness project model and certification process for employer programs; provide for tax credits for projects
HB 246	Flood	Menu labeling: require chain restaurants with 20 or more locations in U.S. to provide a calorie content disclosure statement on menus and menu boards
HB 375	Watkins	Delete requirement for a premium payment for KCHIP; permit Cabinet to establish premiums by administrative regulation
HB 436	Burch	Establish School Nurse Pilot Program to employ licensed nurses in public elementary schools; details; appropriate \$3M
HB 523	Belcher	Kids fitness: require fitness test at start and end of each school year, including BMI; require physical activity, with time tiered by grade levels
SB 86	Harper Angel	Menu labeling: require chain restaurants with 20 or more locations in U.S. to provide a calorie content disclosure statement on menus and menu boards

SR 9	Harper Angel	Urge the Governor to include funding for Medicaid-approved smoking cessation programs in his 2010-2012 Executive Branch budget proposal
SC 192	Williams	Create legislative task force to study cost containment strategies for Medicaid; require a report by 12/31/10; declare emergency
SC 197	Stine	Hire consultant to conduct a performance audit of the Kentucky Medicaid program; report initial findings by 12/1/10 and final recommendations by 3/1/11
